STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Closing Worthley Pond to Ice Fishing, also Closing said Worthley Pond to all Except Fly Fishing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time on or through the ice in the waters of Worthley Pond, said Pond being situated in the town of Poland, in the county of Androscoggin.

- Sec. 2. It shall also be unlawful for any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time in the waters of said Worthley Pond, EXCEPT in the ordinary manner of fishing with artificial flies, or fly fishing, so-called.
- Sec. 3. It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in possession at any time any kind of fish taken in violation of any of the provisions of this act.
- Sec. 4. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall be subject to a penalty of not more than three hundred dollars and costs, or imprisonment for not more than ninety days, or both said fine and imprisonment.
