STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to Ice Fishing in Moosehead Lake in the County of Piscataquis.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Fishing in Moosehead Lake, regulated. The commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation forbidding any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any salmon, trout or togue through the ice in Moosehead Lake in the county of Piscataquis at any time, except that salmon, trout and togue may be taken through the ice in accordance with the general law of the state from said Moosehead Lake during the months of February and March of each year.
