STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to the Apportionment of State Aid to Agricultural Societies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 39, § 25, amended. The 1st sentence of section 25 of chapter 39 of the revised statutes as amended by chapter 24 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 25. State aid to agricultural societies; apportionment; special provision for Maine Pomological Society; procedure for apportioning stipend. There shall be appropriated annually from the state treasury a sum of money not to exceed four two cents per inhabitant of the state, which shall be known as the state stipend for aid and encouragement to agricultural societies and hereafter in this chapter designated as the stipend.
