STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Exempting Horses and Dairy Cows from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 13, § 6, paragraph VI, amended. Paragraph VI of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Horses and dairy cows exempt from taxation. All mules and horses less than 6 months old, not more than 2 horses of any age, not more than 15 dairy cows of any age, when used in connection with the operation of a farm, and neat cattle 18 months old and under, and all sheep to the number of 35, and swine to the number of 10, and domestic fowl to the number of 50.'
