STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Weld Pond.

Fishing in Weld, Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue the following rule and regulation:

'No trout less then 10 inches in length nor any landlocked salmon less than 14 inches in length shall be taken at any time from Weld Pond or Webbs Pond, so-called, in Weld.'
