STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting of Skunks and Raccoons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, § 72, amended. Paragraph D of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes as amended by chapter 127 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Provided further that it shall be lawful to hunt skunks and raccoons, at night when accompanied by a dog and using a rifle not larger than the regular 22 caliber, (the 22 caliber hipower being hereby expressly prohibited) or a shot gun not larger than a 12 gauge using shot not larger than No. 2, and a kerosene light, from the first day of Oetober of each year **Nov. 1st** to Dec. 15th, both days inclusive in the counties of Androscoggin, Cumberland, York, Sagadahoc, Kennebec, Lincoln, Waldo, Knox, and Oxford only; provided further that they procure a \$5.00 license.'
