STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Facilitate Motor Vehicle Traffic on Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Police authorized to facilitate traffic. Any member of the state highway police shall have authority to order the operator of a motor vehicle to operate it at such speed or in such manner as not to unnecessarily obstruct the normal movement of traffic upon any highway; provided the prima facie lawful speed limits are not thereby exceeded. Any operator who refuses or wilfully neglects to comply with an order, so given, shall be subject to the penalties provided in section 119 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes.
