STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to the Use of State Owned Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Officials not to use state cars except on business. No state official or employee shall drive or use any state owned motor car or truck, except when actually engaged in their official state business or work; nor shall any such official or employee permit any member of his or her family to use such motor car or truck.

Whoever violates the provisions of this section forfeits to the state \$25 to be recovered by the treasurer of state in an action of debt.
