STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting and Trapping of Wild Animals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Hunting and trapping of wild animals regulated. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 72 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes as amended by chapter 127 of the public laws of 1931 'The open season in the northern counties for hunting and trapping any fur-bearing animal except wild hares and rabbits, which are protected under section 71 of this chapter, bob-cats, loupcervier, Canada lynx, muskrat or mink, is from October 16, to January 31 both days inclusive, providing that there shall be open season on mink from November 1 to January 31 both days inclusive. In the southern counties the open season shall be from November 1 to January 31 both days inclusive, providing that in the northern counties there shall be open season on muskrat from April 1 to April 30, both days inclusive, also from November 1 to November 30, both days inclusive.

Provided that in the southern counties there shall be an open season on muskrat from March 20 to April 20, both days inclusive.'
