STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Require Drivers of Motor Vehicles to Signal.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Signals required of drivers of motor vehicles. Each driver of a vehicle before slacking its speed, stopping or backing, shall indicate by signal his intention to slacken its speed or stop or to back, and if he intends to turn or change his direction, he shall indicate the direction in which he intends to proceed.
