STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Fix Minimum Prices for Trucks Used in Highway Work.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Minimum prices. The state highway commission shall hereafter cause to be inserted in all contracts for the construction of highways or bridges minimum prices for all sizes of trucks according to the yardage hauled.
- Sec. 2. Penalty. Any contractor making payment to any truck owner for work done on either highways or bridges at a lesser rate or scale than the minimum price established in the contract between such contractor and the state shall be punished by fine of not more than \$50 for each offense.
