RESOLVE, Relating to Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Ferry money, Penobscot tribe of Indians; disposal of. Resolved: That all ferry money collected by the ferryman of the Penobscot tribe of Indians shall constitute a separate fund and shall only be disbursed with the approval of the tribal governor. The statement of all receipts and expenditures of ferry money shall be posted each month by the tribal governor at the Indian agency.
