STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Changing the Time Required to Establish or Lose a Pauper Settlement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Time to establish or lose a pauper settlement reduced to one year. The time required to establish or lose a pauper settlement in a city or town, or in a plantation of the size required by law to support its paupers, shall hereafter be one year continuously without aid at the public expense during that time.

- Sec. 2. Inconsistent acts repealed. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. Time when act shall take effect. This act shall take effect on August 1st, 1933.
