STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to State Aid in Support of Poor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. State shall aid cities, towns and plantations in certain cases. Whenever any city, town or plantation shall support its poor in accordance with standards established by the department of health and welfare, the state shall reimburse said city, town or plantation for the expenses of support of the persons having a settlement therein, in excess of three-quarters of one per cent of the state valuation of said city, town or plantation.
- Sec. 2. Time when act shall take effect. This act shall take effect on August 1st, 1933.
