RESOLVE, for Repairing Homes of Poor and Needy Indians at Old Town Island.

Appropriation for repairing homes of indigent Indians. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,000 to aid in repairing the homes of poor and needy Indians situated on Old Town Island.
