STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Protection of Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Carrying of firearms regulated. Any person may carry firearms while on their own property or property of which they are in charge as lessees, caretakers, employees or members of the family for the purpose of exterminating vermin or wild animals on any day of the week.
