## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Permits for Owning Firearms.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Permit required to own firearms. No person shall have in his possession any gun or pistol without first obtaining a permit from the city or town officials. The permit shall have printed thereon in the lower corner thereof the words registration number, make and caliber with blank spaces thereafter. A fee of 25 cents shall be paid for the above mentioned permit for the use of the town or city.

No person, firm, or corporation shall sell to any person any gun or pistol unless the would-be purchaser files with the seller a copy of his finger prints taken at the time of purchase by the seller. The registration number, make and caliber of the weapon sold together with the name of the purchaser shall be noted on the finger print record. The state highway police shall prepare appropriate records to receive the finger prints and furnish all dealers requesting them with them.
