STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Extending the Time of Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 29, § 55, second paragraph, amended. The second paragraph of section 55 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter 224 of the public laws of 1931, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Operators' licenses. Number plates so furnished shall be valid only for the calendar year for which they are issued, except that on and after December 25th of such calendar year, it shall be lawful to use and display on motor vehicles, the number plates issued for the next succeeding year; provided further, that motor vehicle registrations and license tags issued thereon in any calendar year, also operators' licenses, shall be valid for use and display until March 1st of the next calendar year. Each number plate displayed shall be horizontal and shall be so fastened as not to swing, and its lower edges shall be at least 12 inches from the ground. Not more than I set of number plates shall be displayed upon any vehicle, except as may be otherwise permitted by this chapter.'
