### STATE 0 F MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to Reduction Sentence Convicts in State Prison.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S. c. 152, § 20, amended.** Section 20 of chapter 152 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 20. Warden shall keep a record of each convict's conduct, and recommend a deduction of sentence. He shall keep a record of the conduct of each convict, and for every month, during which it thereby appears that such convict has faithfully observed all the rules and requirements of the prison, the warden may recommend to the executive, a deduction of seven days from the minimum term of said convict's sentence, except those sentenced to imprisonment for life.'
