STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Creating the South Windsor Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

South Windsor game preserve, established. The following described territory is hereby set aside as a game preserve; the territory bounded and described as follows: beginning at route No. 101, at South Windsor, thence southerly by the highway via Snyder's corner and Nolan's corner to Powers' corner, thence from Powers' corner by Keyes' corner to the Chelsea line, thence by Chelsea and Whitfield line to route No. 101, thence by route No. 101 to the point of beginning.
