STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Ice Fishing in Little Sebago Lake Situated in Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Little Sebago Lake located in the towns of Gray and Windham, in Cumberland county, is hereby opened to ice fishing under the provision of the general laws.
