STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to Falsely Assuming to be a Game Warden.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 38, § 110, additional Chapter 38 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding section 110 which shall read as follows:

'Sec. 110. Impersonating game wardens. Any game warden or deputy game warden may arrest with or without warrant any person who impersonates or represents himself as being a game warden or deputy game warden.'
