STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Shipping and Transporting of Clams Beyond the Limit of the State During Closed Time.

Emergency Preamble. Whereas, the shipment of clams regulated by this act will take place before this act would ordinarily take effect and therefore defeat the purposes of this bill for the coming year, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meannig of § 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L. 1931, c. 198, repealed. Chapter 198 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby repealed.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency recited in the preamble this resolve shall take effect when approved.
