STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Taking of Land for Park Purposes by Parsonsfield Kezar Falls Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Parsonsfield Kezar Falls Village Corporation may take land for park purposes. Chapter 216 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 12 of the private and special laws of 1923, is hereby further amended by adding thereto another section, to read as follows:

'Sec. 3-A. May condemn land for park purposes. Said corporation shall in like manner have power to raise money to purchase land for park purposes. It shall follow the same procedure in selecting the land and paying damages, and shall have the same right of eminent domain, regulated by the same right of appeal therefrom as is provided by law for the taking of land for burying grounds.'
