STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Reduce Certain Fees of Deputy Sheriffs for the Next Two Years.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Suspension of certain laws. From the effective date of this act, for a period of 2 years only, the operation of all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby suspended.
- Sec. 2. Fees reduced. All deputy sheriffs attending upon the supreme judicial court or the superior court, or performing special duties under order of the sheriff, shall receive for such services \$4.00 a day.
- Sec. 3. Travel expenses. For travel actually performed on official business, deputy sheriffs shall receive 7 cents per mile.
- Sec. 4. Limitation. This act shall remain in effect for a period of 2 years only from the effective date of this act.
