STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Horatio Lawrence of Pittston.

Pension provided for Horatio Lawrence. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Horatio Lawrence, of Pittston, to be paid from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which he is now receiving.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Horatio Lawrence is the grandson of Edward Lawrence who served in the War of 1812. He is 78 years of age, and badly crippled, and the pension of \$10.00 per month which he is now receiving from the State is not sufficient for his needs. He is in a necessitous condition.
