STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Eleanor C. Ryder, of Newport.

Pension provided for Eleanor C. Ryder. Resolved: That a pension of \$8 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Eleanor C. Ryder, of Newport, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Said Eleanor C. Ryder is 63 years of age, the daughter of Daniel Goodwin of Co. B, 22nd Maine Regiment, who died in 1910, at Hudson, Maine. Mrs. Ryder cared for her father for 24 years without pay. She has no income, is in poor health, and under the care of a doctor.
