STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Authorize the Old Town Herbert Gray School District to Refund Any of Its Bonds Falling Due in the Years 1933 and 1934.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Old Town Herbert Gray School District authorized to refund certain bonds. The Old Town Herbert Gray School District, a quasi-municipal corporation created by chapter 78 of the private and special laws of 1925, is hereby authorized and empowered to refund any of its serial bonds falling due during the years 1933 and 1934 for a period of not exceeding twenty years, upon such terms and conditions as the trustees of said district may determine.
