### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for an Increase in State Pension for Hannah C. McLaughlin of Farmingdale.

Pension provided for Hannah C. McLaughlin. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Hannah C. McLaughlin, of Farmingdale, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature, and shall be in lieu of the state pension which he is now receiving.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Hannah C. McLaughlin is the daughter of William S. Ward who served in Co. I, 24th Me. Inf., during the Civil War. She is 76 years of age. She was granted a pension of \$8 per month by the last legislature. Mrs. McLaughlin states that this amount all goes for medical attention.

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
