STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating the Fishing in Parlin Stream.

Fishing in Parlin Stream, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting all fishing in Parlin Stream and the tributaries thereto, in Parlin Pond township, from the foot of Parlin Pond to the fish screen at the head of the "Falls", and in Graham Pond and the tributaries thereto, under the rules and regulations of the department.
