STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating the Fishing in Bog Brook, in Minot and Mechanic Falls.

Fishing in Bog Brook regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation permitting any person to fish for, take, catch or kill pickerel at any time in the waters of Bog Brook, in the towns of Minot and Mechanic Falls, in the county of Androscoggin, from Buckman's Bridge, so-called, to the Little Androscoggin River.
