## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Frank G. Downer of Palermo.

Frank G. Downer, pension for. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Frank G. Downer of Palermo, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Frank G. Downer is the son of William G. Downer who had an honorable service in the 14th Maine Regiment, during the Civil War. He is 64 years of age. In November, 1927, he was thrown from a truck and suffered a broken leg. The break did not heal, and he was finally obliged to have the leg amputated above the knee. His wife is in poor health, and because of his advanced years and disability, he is unable to earn a sufficient amount for her support and the support of himself. His children are not financially able to assist him, and he is in urgent need of help.
