STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating the Fishing in Milliken's Mill Pond in the Town of Old Orchard Beach in the County of York.

Regulating the fishing in Milliken's Mill Pond. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting fishing in Milliken's Mill Pond and the tributaries thereto situated in the town of Old Orchard Beach in the county of York, except fly fishing, so-called, with unbaited artificial flies, with a bag limit of not more than 5 fish in all in any I day.
