STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Sweet's Pond, or Porter Lake in the Towns of New Vineyard and Strong, in the County of Franklin.

Regulating ice fishing in Sweet's pond. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to ice fishing Sweet's Pond or Porter Lake in towns of New Vineyard and Strong in the county of Franklin, on Friday of each week under the general laws of the state.
