STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Frank C. Davis, of Jefferson.

Frank C. Davis; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Frank C. Davis, of Jefferson, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Frank C. Davis is the son of Alvah M. Davis who enlisted May 30, 1862, and was mustered August 14, 1862, in Co. E, 16th Maine Infantry; discharged for disability on November 26, 1862; reenlisted July 31, 1863, and was honorably discharged on July 12, 1865.

Frank C. Davis is now well along in years. He is unable to obtain sufficient work to give him a livelihood. He is a worthy citizen and deserving of assistance.
