STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Charles Dowling Kidder, of Otisfield.

Charles Dowling Kidder; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$20 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Charles Dowling Kidder of Otisfield, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue for 2 years.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Kidder enlisted on August 15, 1917, and had an honorable discharge on September 2, 1919. Mr. Kidder has been unable to work since March, 1931, on account of a general breakdown in his health.

Mr. Kidder has been receiving aid from the Red Cross in Portland.

Mr. Kidder was in the air corps of the World War.

Mr. Kidder is affected with neurasthenia, and his mental condition is very serious.
