#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Joseph B. Pelletier, of Winterville Plantation.

Joseph B. Pelletier; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$15 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Joseph B. Pelletier, of Winterville Plantation, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Joseph B. Pelletier is the father of a World War veteran who had honorable service. He is advanced in years and has lost a leg, and for these reasons is unable to earn a livelihood for himself and wife. His son is in poor health and is receiving disability compensation from the Government. He has a large family and is not able to help his father. Joseph B. Pelletier is in a destitute condition and is worthy of assistance.
