STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Bids for Supplies to Institutions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Institution supplies to be bid for separately. The state purchasing agent, in requesting bids for institutional supplies, shall list the articles on which bids are requested under the names of the institutions for which they are desired. Bids shall be made on any or all of the articles listed, each bid being made for the supply of a specific article or articles to the particular institution without reference to those otherwise listed.'
