STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT to Confer Additional Rights and Powers Upon East Branch Improvement Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Additional rights and powers. The East Branch Improvement Company, a corporation incorporated by special act of the legislature of Maine entitled "An Act to incorporate the East Branch Improvement Company," approved March 18, 1903, is hereby authorized and empowered in addition to the rights that it now possesses, to hold and store water for manufacturing and power purposes upon any or all of its dams and works, without prejudice however to log driving purposes.
- **Sec. 2.** Inconsistent acts. Anything in said charter of said East Branch Improvement Company or any amendment or amendments thereof inconsistent therewith is hereby repealed.
