STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

Bill "An Act to Reduce Certain Fees of Deputy Sheriffs for the Next Two Years."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and substituting in its place the following:

- Sec. 1. Suspension of certain laws. From the effective date of this act for a period of 2 years only, the operation of paragraph 23 of section 4 of chapter 126 of the revised statutes is hereby suspended.
- Sec. 2. Per diem and expenses deputy sheriffs. Every deputy sheriff, while performing special duties under order of the sheriff shall receive for such services five dellars \$4.50 a day, together with necessary, incidental expenses, including travel actually performed on official business at not exceeding 7 cents per mile, to be paid from the county treasury, the bills for which shall be audited as provided in section I of chapter 148. Provided, however, that such officers shall not be entitled to fees for any services rendered in criminal matters while acting as per diem officers.
- Sec. 3. Limitation. This act shall remain in effect for a period of 2 years only from the effective date of this act.
