IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Daniel Mahar, of Bangor.

Daniel Mahar of Bangor, compensated. Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of \$300 to be paid to Daniel Mahar, of Bangor, to compensate him in full for the taking of talking pictures at the request of the secretary of former governor Parkhurst.
