STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relative to Fishing in the Saco River in the County of York.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 21, additional. Section 21 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

'It shall be lawful to fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish in the Saco River in the county of York from the mouth of said river up to the Buxton town line from April 1st to December 15th, both days inclusive of each year, except that no trout, salmon, white perch or black bass shall be taken from said river from September 15th to the 1st day of the following April.'
