## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in York County.

Fishing in York county, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation fixing the closing date on fishing in the waters of York county to coincide with the general law, and the opening date to be on April 15, of each year.
