## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Relative to Ice Fishing in Moosehead Lake in the Counties of Piscataquis and Somerset.

Fishing in Moosehead lake, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation forbidding any person to fish for, take, catch or kill any salmon, trout or togue through the ice in Moosehead lake in the counties of Piscataquis and Somerset at any time, except that salmon, trout and togue may be taken through the ice in accordance with the general law of the state from said Moosehead lake from February 1st to April 15th, both days inclusive.
