IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Opening West Branch of Dead Stream to Fishing.

West Branch of Dead Stream and tributaries open to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to fishing under the general law the West Branch of Dead Stream and its tributaries in the town of Bradford in Penobscot county and in the town of Atkinson in Piscataquis county.
