STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, In Favor of a Pension for Richard T. Kensell of Alna.

Richard T. Kensell; state pension. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, granted to Richard T. Kensell of Alna, a pension of \$20 per month to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1933, and continue for 2 years.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Kensell enlisted in 1917 in the air service, and was discharged March 18, 1919 as a sergeant. He is totally disabled, and receives a pension of \$12 per month from the Government. He is being helped by the town at present.
