## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Lottie J. Jones, of Washington.

Lottie J. Jones; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Lottie J. Jones of Washington, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Lottie J. Jones is the daughter of Alonzo L. Farrow who served in Co. F, 21st Maine Inf., during the Civil War. He was honorably discharged August 25, 1863. She has been a cripple for many years; her husband is out of employment, and the family are having a hard time to get along.
