STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for William E. Dill, of Randolph.

William E. Dill; state pension. Resolved: That the pension of \$10 per month be, and hereby is, granted to William E. Dill, of Randolph, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

William E. Dill is the son of Charles H. Dill who enlisted September 10, 1862, in Company 1, 24th Maine Infantry, and was mustered out and honorably discharged August 25th, 1863. He is 75 years of age; does not have steady employment, and is in need of financial assistance.
