STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Arthur P. Sanborn of West Baldwin.

Pension provided for Arthur P. Sanborn. Resolved: That a pension of \$8 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Arthur P. Sanborn of West Baldwin to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Arthur P. Sanborn is the son of the late John Sanborn who served in Co. K, 17th Maine Infantry Volunteer during the Civil War. He is 75 years of age, his physical condition and eyesight are poor and he is without means of support.
