STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Incorporation of Cousins and Littlejohns Islands

Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1925, c. 27, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 27 of the private and special laws of 1925 is hereby amended to read as follows.
- 'Sec. 3. Appropriation and expenditure of money. All monies which shall be raised by the town of Yarmouth by special action under the provisions of this act, The town of Yarmouth shall annually appropriate and raise the sum of \$1500 for use on the territory included within the limits of said village corporation, not including monies raised for general town purposes which shall be expended only upon the request of and for such purposes as the board of overseers of said corporation may direct.'
